

The Responsibility of Talent

Paul believed that the second coming of Christ was imminent. Hence, he urges the Thessalonians to be watchful. However, Matthew has accepted that the Parousia would be delayed. Even so, he too spoke about the necessity of being watchful. In the parable of the talents he spells out what this watchfulness consists of: it consists in carrying out the Lord's instructions to the best of one's God-given ability.

The first reading sets before us the example of a woman who uses her talents to live an industrious and virtuous life.




